The general expectation is that classes will take place in the evenings and occasional weekends, with a mixture of in-classroom and online instruction. As we finalize updates to our curriculum, exact course names and class schedule will be forthcoming.

Students with a Bachelor's Degree in Social Work complete the program with a minimum of 27 s.h. required social work credits and 9 s.h. electives, beginning in Summer 2023. Students with a Bachelor's Degree in another discipline complete the program with a minimum of 45 s.h. required social work credits and 9 s.h. electives, beginning in Summer 2022. **Financial aid and deferment of previous student loans is possible if you are registered for at least 5 s.h. in fall and spring semesters and 3 s.h. in summer.**
