[Programmatic assessment done through a programming evaluation and qualitative interviews will determine if participants experience an increase in knowledge and awareness about educational topics presented, if participants increase their awareness of and feeling of connection to the participating UI units and determine if logistical changes need to be made to the virtual presentations and program format to better serve the residents of Senior Living Communities (SLCs). Additional research done in partnership with the Aging and Longevity Studies Program (ALSP) involves evaluation with select volunteer SLCs and organizations for older adults to explore feelings of connection, isolation, loneliness, wellbeing, and stress due to the Covid-19 pandemic and better understand whether participation in the Connected for Life educational program impacts these feelings.]
