

**Criteria to enroll in “professional core” social work courses which start in fall.**

**Three pre-requisite courses must be completed with a C grade or better:**

SSW: 1022 Social Justice and Social Welfare in the U.S.	SOC 160 Intro Social Work
PSY:1001 Elementary Psychology	PSY 111
SOC:1010 Introduction to Sociology	SOC 110

**And student meets these requirements:**

- 2.0 G.P.A. minimum overall
- Completion of 45 s.h. or more

**Social work-required course that may be completed before or after admission to the School of Social Work**
