

Announcing the H. Wayne and Donna J. Johnson Award for Social Work Undergraduate Students

The School of Social Work is currently accepting applications for the H. Wayne and Donna J. Johnson Award for Social Work Undergraduate Students. H. Wayne Johnson served on the faculty of the School of Social Work and was the BA Coordinator for 38 years. The H. Wayne Johnson BA Program in Social Work is named in honor of his commitment to and leadership in undergraduate education at The University of Iowa.

This scholarship is to support an undergraduate social work student who has been admitted to the major. **Both students who are currently Juniors or Seniors are eligible for the award.** An award of up to \$1000 will be made annually. **The criteria for the award is financial need, academic excellence (minimum 3.2 g.p.a.) and aptitude for and commitment to the profession.**

Students self-nominate.

The application includes:

- financial information entry
- a one-page self-nomination demonstrating aptitude for and commitment to the social work profession
- the name of a social work faculty reference

The student's application materials which were submitted for admission to the School of Social Work and an unofficial current transcript will be applied to the application by the School of Social Work administrative office.

Application deadline is November 8, 2024. The selection will be made on or about December 15 with disbursement of the \$1000 award to be made to the student's University account in January, 2025

How to Apply:

- Accept invitation to join *School of Social Work Scholarships* ICON site.
- Once in the site, locate the Module titled, H. Wayne and Donna Johnson Scholarship.
- Upload your statement with your name at the top and the name of a social work faculty member who agreed to be a reference.
- Complete the Financial Information for Scholarship Application form in the ICON site.
