

# Preparing for your BA in Social Work from The University of Iowa in Iowa City

### **Southeastern CC (West Burlington)**

#### Criteria to enroll in professional core social work courses which start in fall.

Three pre-requisite courses must be completed with a C grade or better:

SSW: 1022 Social Justice and Social Welfare in the U.S.	SOC 160 Intro Social Work
PSY:1001 Elementary Psychology	PSY 111
SOC:1010 Introduction to Sociology	SOC 110

#### And student meets these requirements:

- 2.0 G.P.A. minimum overall
- Completion of 45 s.h. or more
- Submits a signed Professional Social Work Agreement form (signed after criteria is met)
