Announcing the Former Faculty BA Social Work & MSW Scholarships

The Former Faculty Scholarship (\$1000) is given annually to one undergraduate (BA) social work student who is enrolled in the professional core courses and one graduate (MSW) student. The Scholarships are awarded from funds that have been donated to the School in memory of deceased faculty along with donations from faculty, current and former students and friends of retiring faculty to honor their contributions to the School during their tenure. A committee of the former faculty has set the following eligibility criteria for the scholarships and invites all eligible BSW and MSW students to apply.

Eligibility Criteria

- Creative activities that advance the profession of Social Work or a demonstrated interest in international issues.
- Financial Need

Students may self-nominate.

The application includes:

- Financial information entry
- A 2-page essay (double-spaced) which addresses the criteria identifying either your creative activities to benefit the profession or international interests.

An unofficial current transcript will be applied to the application by the School of Social Work administrative office.

Application deadline: Friday, November 8, 2024. The selection will be made on or about December 15, 2024 with disbursement of the \$1000 award to be made to the student's University account in January 2025.
